Perspective Plan for the next 5 years

We have taken a decision in our last general meeting we extend our working areas from Gangetic new Alluvial zone to Undulating Lateritic Red zone particularly for betterment of tribal farmers community.

This year is a crucial problematic year to us because of all Governmental Projects and fundraising already terminated. Although NZFDO is now a self sufficient Organization maximum funds are come from our Seeds Business. Vermi-compost selling and various agricultural implement, tools etc. service providing programme. For this reason we are trying to change our previous administrative policy for maintaining the flow of our developmental wave. Now we going to a self sufficient Organization.

From this year we have recruited some consultant for the up liftmen of our Organization. From the year NZFDO was shaped by some key processes. Extensive consultation with internal and external stakeholders, including community members. Led us to adopt a systems thinking approach This shifting marks a significant departure from our previous method of thinking and aimed at effecting substantial social change in rural Bengal particularly among women, tribal and marginalized groups.

The objective is to tackle systemic obstacles and create scalable prototype through grassroots initiative an Organizational renewal process to facilitate strategic shifts towards working am scale by unlocking leadership potential. The operating structure is now recognized at district then will be one district to another all over the Bengal. Monitoring, Evolution and learning (MEL) and technology functions are newly incorporated. Moreover, the following centre, Agriculture, farmer producer, farmers club, CBOs climate action groups SHGs, and nutrition, livestock and forestation respectively have been established. Professionals having expertise on these thematic areas. In such a way our central functionary groups as leads to help sharpen our on ground development work and strengthen collaboration with external stakeholders.

Besides this we try to open Farmers community college. It will be mandatory that only farmers will be the student there will no age bar. Some teachers coming here from progressive farmers. Another target to establish field school in different Panchayet area. From today we are trying to create funds raising.

OUR ORGANIZATIONAL ACTIVITIES IN THE DIFFERENT WORKING AREAS

Survey work

This year we have performed a special type survey works from the area of the Village Kalamari, Haronagar, Jatrapur under the Hanskhali Blocks, Village Hatisala, Mahesnagar, Baraandulia of Nadia. The survey work on 'Yield Gaps Rice Cultivation details of Progressive farmers schedule ICAR-Indian Institute of Rice Research, Hyderabad' This survey work very were sincerely performed by Three staffs of our Organization. Initially they contact with Gram Panchayet Proddhan. Then had collected their necessary datas from the farmers in participatory mode the with sincere help G. P. Staff Mr. Shyam Sher Ali. We thanks to them those help us to perform this work. Prof. P.A.Lakshmi Prasanna from ICAR-IIRR, Hyderabad congratulate to us and assured me. She is keenly interested to do this type of work with our Organization.

AGRICULTURAL IMPLEMENTS FREE DISTRIBUTION

As like as previous year we distributed Napsak Sprayer Machine as free of cost among the 125 progressive farmers of our different working areas. Previously we provide to the SC and ST candidates only. For this reason a group of farmers from General category of different villages repeatedly appeal to us to get free of cost only one Napsak Sprayer Machine from our Organization. Then we collected nearly 234 applications from the farmers. After selection 125 candidates we distributed among the poor and real progressive cultivators.

RICE SEEDS PRODUCTION ACTIVITIES IN THE FARMERS PLOT

During the last ten years our Organization have Rice seeds production Programme. It is a self sufficiency programme of NZFDO. We have total permanent staff 16 and casual staff 35 they are seasonal skilled labour used to work rice seeds processing work both (season aman and boro rice). Lion portion of their salary payment is coming from this business. We are willing to establish a big seeds processing unit. For this we are searching favourable location for near about 1.5 to 2 bigha land. Besides this we have another profitable two units. One is vermin-composting unit another is plant nursery. Both units have positive response from our buyer. Farmers are purchasing Rice seeds in the both season (Kharif and Boro) at very low prices. We also providing this before the farmer because we maintain

seeds quality, we have no packaging costs. We try to collect good variety of mother seeds from Chinsurah Rice Research Station. But our man power are very poor at presently we require minimum 10 permanent labour.

In Organizational income generating activities namely Rice Seeds Production Programme, Vermi-compost Production Programme, Women dress Designing Programme, Agricultural Farm Machinery and Implements hired out Programme, flower and fruit plant nursery. In the all Organizational self-sufficiency Programme day after day gradually increasing. Farmers are purchasing seasonal crop seeds from our sales counter at a very reasonable price. In such a way we are trying to establish our Organizational Rice seeds Production Programmes with farmers in participatory mode.

Through the demonstration of different on Farm Trial of our various Research Institute(NBRI , Lucknow , Universities (DDU University ,Gorakhpur UP, BCKV, Mohanpur W.B) ,I.C.A.R (ICAR-IRRI Hyderabad) and Department of Agriculture Government of West Bengal .

Next I come to the Vermi-compost Production Programme . This programmed also running properly it's a golden programme of NGO. But insufficient working labours are working there. Cow dung also available but collection method are not improved. We require one Cycle Van urgently.

WOMEN EMPOWERMENT THROUGH SKILL DEVELOPMENT

In collaboration with the Rama Krishna Mission Samaj Sevak Sikshan Mandir Belur Math , Howrah) . There are two programmed one is the Vegetable Nursery Management and another Women Dress Designing Training Programmed. These are the entrepreneurship development Programme actually coming from RUDESTI Type institute in collaboration with Punjab National Bank and NABARD, Ministry of Rural Development We start this programmed from the year 2016. In connection with the Women Dress Designing Programmed our both the Teachers Mrs Sujata Das and Mrs Soma Ghoshare doing maximum practical classes for the better development of Trainees . These training material are selling our Centre . Beside this some good quality cloths we purchasing from the market a few numbers of skilled women trainees prepare these dresses. They also earning some wages from NGO. Gradually market demand of these all products increasing. But we require two to three sewing machine in the coming year.

Next I want to clarify “ The Agricultural Farm Machinery and Implements ,Tools hired out Programme. This programmed earns some money as service providers role of NGO to the farmer community . But there are some problems from the beneficiaries maximum payment of rents of the machine are due. So, gradually we try to Minimizing our capital from this activities.

Another Project the Promotion of Floriculture in two district of West Bengal under the Principal Scientist, Dr. Sekhar Mallick of NBRI (National botanical Research Institute, Lucknow , UP). The proper guidance of our Principal Adviser Dr. Bhanudeb Bagchi and Prof. Anil Chandra Prodhan it had been running from the last year. For the Livelihood upliftment of the flower producer in the area of the Block of Ranaghat I & II near about 247 farmer are associated and benefited with this programmed .The NBRI release 2,50,000/- to 275000/- yly to the NGO. A group of Scientist from NBRI in the last month come to visit this activities of this programmed. They become highly satisfy and assured from the next year project budget may be increased. It is have possible only

The impact of this project work we are opening another sales counter for Nursery Plant selling. From this counter we also earn some money. Already we get a offers from NBRI to established a new nursery of one bigha land. We request to all of us please search a plot of land area one to two bigha high land for open a nursery in the rental basis. We had selected two progressive flower producer farmer Mr. Nirmal Debnath and Amaresh Mondal to participate in the Flower exhibition and Workshop at National Botanical Research Institute , Lucknow (U.P.) . Both person are very much happy on our Organization.

OILSEED EXTENSION PROGRAMME

With the collaboration of different Multi - national seeds company we distributed mustard seeds free of cost to 120 farmers . Our target to encourage the farmers to operate this cash crop. It protect our ground water level. It will take a short time so that our cropping system will developed. It will developed the livelihood of small farmers.

MULTI-LOCATIONAL RICE TRIAL PRPGRAMME IN HIGHLY ARSENIC CONTAMINATED AREA OF WEST BENGAL (INCLUDING CRRS, CSIR-NBRI,DDU UNIVERSITY GORAKHPUR

The another projects on ‘**Development of rice –grain arsenic removal technique /method for rural population of Arsenic affected area of West Bengal**’ running smoothly from NBRI,” The Multi – location K

Kharif & Boro Rice on Farm Trial in the highly Arsenic contaminated Area in four district of West Bengal”.The Principal Scientist Dr. Sanjoy Dwibedi. The proper guidance of our panel scientist we are doing this program during the last 8 years. The yearly turnover of this Project near about 200,000 /- 250,000/- (Two Lakh to 2.5 lakh).

It is very good news to us the Department of Chemistry , DDU University of Gorakhpur had sanctioned a Rice trial project from last year as like as NBRI. This is the MULTI LOCATION DIFFERENT VARITIES RICE PRE-KHARIF, KHARIF AND SUMMER RICE IN HIGHLY EFFECTED DISTRICT IN WEST BENGAL (PREFER TO INADEGENEOUS AROMATIC RICE) , Dr. Seema Mishra is the Principal Investigator of this Programme and yearly turn over this project 3 lakh to 3.5 lakh yearly may be increased. For this all type of trial works in the different district we need agricultural lands in terms of yearly contract basis paid to the farmers 15,000/- to 16000/- rental per bigha . We expenses maximum travelling heads to follow up the all activities in several districts all over the year. The Water and soil collection for the testing of Arsenic availability from different locations it is also another maximum expenses heads.

We want to do the extension work from one farmer to another so that new low cost all technology and nano technology reach all the agro climatic zone our state of West Bengal. We always want to display new information to the farmers community through different electronic media and newsletters, newspapers, periodicals, leaflets and local agricultural journal. We distribute agricultural journal, periodicals, leaflets, handbill in both language English and Bengali.

Throughout the year to create deep interest and make inspiration our farmers, trainee of SHGs, SGSY groups from different corners. We send them to visit the different Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Nadia at Gayeshpur, Chinsurah Rice Research Station, Narendrapur Rama Krishna Mission, R.K Mission Belur Math, Government Wire House at Krishnanagar, Private Seeds Farms, All travelling costs bear our Organization. We have done all these type of Exposer visit to encourage our beneficiaries.

During the year we have done various type of awareness camp on several sectors such as health check up of senior citizen, dots, deficiency of Sodium, potassium, iodine in human body, target group SHGs, SGSY women and Men also

FARMERS TRAINING PROGRAMME

Throughout year from the beginning of the each crop season we arrange different Farmers need based Training Programme on crop cultivation.

This year we conduct 12 one day training programmes in 5 district (Nadia, Purba Bardhaman, North 24 Parganas, Hooghly, Murshidabad) on Boro and Aman Paddy seeds Production.

This year we performed 4 programmes on Flour Cultivation in Nadia & Murshidabad. We also organized 4 Workshop on Pest and Diseases management of Vegetable Crops in Nadia.

We arranged 4 Integrated Pest Management (IPM) Training in Nadia and Purba Bardhaman.

We organized 4 Seminars on Modern Nursery Management on Flower and Orchards crop in Nadia.

In addition, NZFDO provided valuable support in organizing a one day awareness and demonstration workshop on “**Minimization of arsenic from rice grain during cooking**”, held in 2022 at Ghetugacchi, Chakdaha, a severely arsenic-contaminated area in Nadia district, West Bengal.
